Ossory Youth

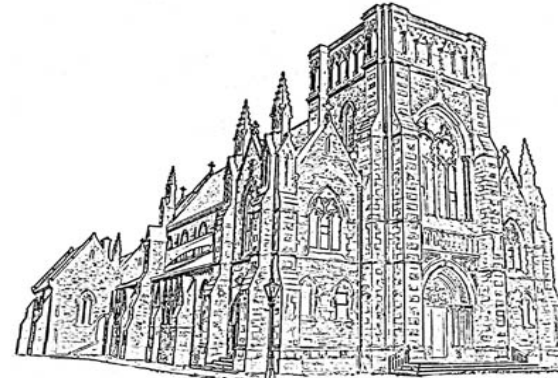
Ossory Youth are currently recruiting young people for their annual summer outdoor adventure programme for 12-14 years olds.

Stop The Lights!

Perhaps it’s timely once again to remind all our parishioners and visitors to St John’s church to be very careful when exiting the grounds with a vehicle – especially at the barrier exit.

Some drivers seem to assume that, when the barrier rises, it’s ok to drive on and exit immediately!

This is not so. In fact it’s highly dangerous.

All vehicles exiting the grounds should drive up to the white line when the barrier rises **and then STOP & WAIT for the green traffic-light in front of you before completing the exit.**

Caution should also be exercised with regard to pedestrians and cyclists, as they seldom obey the ‘red man’ when crossing that junction.

At weekends, when the main gates are open after mass, great care should also be taken when leaving the grounds.
