Mill Hill Missionaries

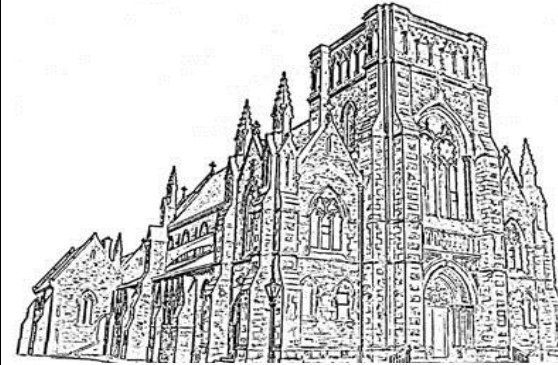
