The Church has been celebrating the World Day of Migrants and Refugees since 1914. It is always an occasion to express concern for many different vulnerable people on the move; to pray for the challenges and increase awareness about the opportunities that migration offers.

This year, the World Day will be celebrated next Sunday, **September 29th**. Pope Francis has chosen the theme "**It is not just about migrants**" to show up our blind-spots and make sure no one remains excluded from society, whether a long-time resident or someone newly-arrived.

"Dear brothers and sisters, our response to the challenges posed by contemporary migration can be summed up in four verbs: *welcome, protect, promote and integrate.* Yet these verbs do not apply only to migrants and refugees. They describe the Church's mission to all those living in the existential peripheries, who need to be welcomed, protected, promoted and integrated.

If we put those four verbs into practice, we will help build the city of God and man. We will promote the integral human development of all people. We will also help the world community to come closer to the goals of sustainable development that it has set for itself and that, lacking such an approach, will prove difficult to achieve." **Pope Francis**
