The Olympic Bell

During the Paris Olympic Games, track and field champions rang a bronze bell located close to the finish line in the stadium. Later this year the bell will be placed in the newly re-opened Notre Dame Cathedral in Parish.

The cathedral's rector, Father Olivier Ribadeau Dumas, was contacted a few months before the Paris Olympics to see if the Paris Cathedral would be interested in this bell for Notre Dame. The bell, weighing 1,103 lbs was made by the Cornille Havard foundry located in Normandy. The same company has been responsible for the restoration of eight of these nine bells in the cathedral, after they had been damaged during the fire of 15th April 2019.

The Olympic Games bell will join two other bells, newly cast by the same company, which will be placed inside the cathedral. These three bells will ring together during Mass, at the moment of the consecration. They will replace the bells that were used before the fire completely destroyed that site.



A Mystic and Maronite hermit, St Charbel was born in 1828 in Lebanon and at the age of 20 became a Maronite monk at Annava Abbey. As a hermit, Charbel

was famous for his spiritual gifts. He spent almost a quarter of a century displaying many miraculous abilities and was noted for his love of the Holy Eucharist.

St. Charbel died in 1898. He was beatified in 1965 and canonized in 1977 by Pope Paul VI. There are over 26,000 miracles attributed to the intercession of Saint Charbel Makhlouf since his death in 1898.
